Greetings from OVS

We hope that everyone had a safe, peaceful and enjoyable spring break and are ready for the last stretch before the end of this school year. Your child's attendance will be critical for them to continue to learn as much as they can in the last term, to help them engage in important learning outcomes and to prepare them for their next grade level. Did you know that a cause of absenteeism may be how a child uses technology at home? When students stay up too late on their devices or stay on their devices for too long they may be too ill or tired to come to school or function at school at their best (this happens much more than some people may think). The negative effects of online drama and cyberbullying also have negative affects on attendance (this also happens much more than people may think).

So what can you do at home to help with attendance concerns that may be related to device usage?

 Establish clear rules regarding technology (i.e. cell phones, tablets, video game consoles etc.) in your home. Set time limits and behavior expectations.

- No tech one hour before bed.
 (studies have proven that the "blue" light" from devices interfere with natural sleep cycles and delay sleep).
- Limit tech use during weekdays, weekends and holidays. For example 2 hours a day on weekends and holidays and even less during a school night.
- No tech in bedrooms.
 - studies have shown that devices in bedrooms are linked to sleep problems, increased risk for sexting, conflict and cyberbullying that puts a child at risk for hurtful and predatory behavior.
 - Unsupervised, night tech use is a prime opportunity for risk of cyberbullying and predatory behavior. Limiting device access helps ensure that a child is not being constantly bombarded with or delivering negative, harmful messages.
 - Suggestion: establish the parent's bedroom as the "house charging station" so at night all devices are charged in that location, thus reducing the opportunity for bedroom device use by children, especially at night.
